Pennsylvania Attorney General **Tom Corbett** is being honored as the 2009 Civic Champion for Children in recognition of his efforts to keep children safe, especially online. Since he was elected as Attorney General in 2004, Corbett has been dedicated to making Pennsylvania a safer and better place for families to live, work and grow. Attorney General Corbett identified Internet safety as one of the most serious threats facing families and created the Attorney General's Child Predator Unit to identify and capture Internet predators before they can harm children. More than 237 suspected Internet predators have been arrested. As part of this effort, he launched an Internet safety program called "Operation Safe Surf," designed to help educate not only kids and schools about Internet safety, but to also show parents how they can help keep their children safe online. He is also dedicated to fighting illegal drugs and reducing the drug-related crime that endangers our communities. Corbett has a long and distinguished career serving the citizens of the Commonwealth, making a significant impact on the lives of families in Philadelphia and throughout Pennsylvania.

Daniel K.
